From 11 February to 9 March 2012, NGV Studio will glow with an exhibition by artist group Fluoresce Studio.

Through projection, painting, adhesive murals and craft-based processes, eight Melbourne-based female artists invite NGV Studio visitors to engage with the visual potential of fluorescent colour.

Over the course of the exhibition the artists will be making NGV Studio their home. The space will be used as a testing ground for experimentation, collaboration and the creation of new works to be presented at the closing of the show.

The artists share an interest in fluorescent colour born from the brightness found in the natural world as well as the flashy fashions of fluorescent colours that came to the fore in the 1980s.

Rowena Martinich, Fluoresce Coordinator and Guest Curator said: "Fluorescent communication heightens optical experience and our perception of colour. The artists in Fluoresce Studio exploit this understanding - manipulating their chosen medium to arrest our senses into a state of wonder and contemplation."
