The NGV presents *David Hockney: Current*, a major solo exhibition of one of the most influential living artists. The exhibition, curated by the NGV in collaboration with David Hockney and his studio, features more than 700 works from the past decade of the artist's career – some new and many never-before-seen in Australia – including paintings, digital drawings, photography and video works.

Exhibition highlights include more than 600 extraordinary and sometimes animated iPad digital drawings of still life compositions, self-portraits and large-scale landscapes including scenes of Yosemite National Park. Another highlight is *The Four Seasons, Woldgate Woods*, a breath-taking and immersive video work showcasing the changing landscape of Hockney's native Yorkshire, each season comprised of nine high-definition screens. A dedicated 35-metre long gallery lined with more than eighty recently painted acrylic portrait paintings of the artist's family, friends and notable subjects including artists John Baldessari and Barry Humphries is also a major highlight.

Arguably Britain's greatest living painter, David Hockney, seventy-eight, works prolifically, experimenting and mastering new technologies, creating works on iPhone, iPad and in video. *David Hockney: Current* includes *Bigger trees near Warter*, Hockney's largest painting comprised of fifty oil on canvas panels, and the centrepiece of Hockney's hugely popular exhibition *Bigger Picture* at the Royal Academy, London. Hockney subsequently gifted the work to the Tate London and this is the first time it has been exhibited in Australia. *Bigger Trees near Warter* hangs on one wall of the gallery space, while the remaining three walls display 1:1 digital versions of the same work.

Introductory Talk – Explore the world of David Hockney Year 5–12

Explore the fascinating world and art practice of David Hockney. This introductory talk will focus on key themes and ideas in the exhibition, highlighting the artist's radical reworking of pictorial conventions and traditions in landscapes, portraiture and still life, and his innovative use of technologies, including iPad and iPhone, for creating and presenting art.

An introduction to David Hockney for young learners. This lively introduction will engage students' interest and imagination through a focus on a selection of key works in the exhibition and related questions and activities.

Drawing with Hockney *

All levels

Humble everyday objects emerge transformed and vibrant in Hockney's drawings. Choose your subject matter from an interesting array of objects

in our studio workshop and take inspiration from Hockney's innovative and expressive drawings to create your own contemporary still life. Students will experiment with mark-making, layering and colour in this drawing workshop using traditional or digital media (iPads) to create their work.

Writing with Hockney *

Recommended for Years 6–12

Hockney is inspired by literature and poetry. Explore the links between art and writing in Hockney's work in an introductory talk, followed by a self-guided viewing of the exhibition. Hockney's evocative works reveal a great deal about his subjects, but there is so much more to tell! Take part in a writing workshop using portraits to inspire rich exploration of character and voice, and landscapes to inspire poetry.

Recommended for Years 10–12

David Hockney has been described as a radical traditionalist. Through a focus on selected works in the NGV Collection, explore some of the pictorial traditions and ideas that have informed Hockney's innovative practice and compare his work with that of other contemporary artists.
