More than 400,000 visit MoMA at NGV

9 June 2018 - 8 October 2018 | NGV International | Admission fees apply



15 October 2018: Direct from New York and co-curated by the NGV and the Museum of Modern Art. MoMA at NGV: 130 Years of Modern and Contemporary Art was visited by 404,034 visitors before closing its doors earlier this week.

Extended due to popular demand, the exhibition is NGV's second most attended ticketed exhibition on record.

The internationally exclusive MoMA at NGV: 130 Years of Modern and Contemporary Art presented more than 230 modern and contemporary masterpieces by artists including

Georgia O'Keeffe, Vincent van Gogh and Frida Kahlo. Part of the Victorian Government's Melbourne Winter Masterpieces series, the exhibition was the largest instalment of the series to date.

The exhibition was celebrated with MEL&NYC, a state-wide cultural festival which featured theatre, dance, live music, talks, performance, dining and community-led events, presented by leading Melbourne organisations and communities that explored culture, politics, business and the everyday experience as seen through the eyes of New Yorkers and Australians.

The next major exhibition at NGV International will be the highly anticipated Summer blockbuster, *Escher x* nendo | Between Two Worlds on 2 December.
