# Application for Start Up - Top Arts 2016 The Ian Potter Centre: NGV Australia

#### Instructions for submission

Please submit work which is likely to achieve a high score and is available for exhibition from April to July 2016. Students may complete multiple application forms with up to 5 photographs/images or a DVD if screen based work - per application. Complete all details on the other side of this form

- 1. Use <u>separate application forms for each artwork or series</u> and <u>place each application in a separate A4 sleeve</u>. Staple multiple application forms together. Do not use presentation folders or binders, or pin photographs to the application form.
- VCE Art students can submit up to <u>5 photographs per application that represent the resolution of the student's ideas</u> as represented in their body of work. Short-listed Art students will be required to deliver artworks and support material from the body of work for final selection in early December 2015.
- 3. **VCE Studio Arts** students can submit up to <u>5 photographs per application of finished artworks</u> selected from the folio that are based on <u>potential directions</u> as identified in their <u>focus reflection and evaluation document</u>. Short-listed Studio Arts students will be required to deliver both School assessed Task 1 Exploration Proposal/design process and all of School-assessed Task 2 for final selection in early December 2015.
- 4. Label each photo on the back with applicant's name and title of work and mark with an arrow indicating the top of image if unclear. Short listing can depend on good photographs. See www.vcaa.vic.edu.au/seasonofexcellence.html for tips on taking good photographs.
- 5. If submitting digital photography, provide hardcopy images. Do not submit any photography on CD or DVD unless your work is screen-based work. Film, performance, multimedia or web pages should be submitted on CD/DVD.
- 6. For screen based works please write applicant's name on each CD or DVD. Students should have copyright clearance for non-original material used. Please submit in a format that can be viewed on a PC or Mac and can be opened and viewed easily. (See copyright information below).
- 7. Provide a home/personal email for each application, **not** a school email.

#### Note: No application material will be returned to applicants.

#### Copyright clearance

Work submitted to *Top Arts* that does not have copyright clearance for the use of non-original material cannot be considered for exhibition or screening. This includes audio material, video clips, images from websites and images from publications including logos. While works produced and submitted for school assessment do not contravene copyright legislation, once they are displayed in or published for Season of Excellence events their legal status changes. Applicants should seek clearance for all non-original material used particularly in the case of music for films and multimedia.

Please attach documentation to show that copyright clearance for non-original material has been obtained for the period 1 April to 30 July 2016 and the email or letter sent to the copyright holder by the applicant. Works without copyright clearance will not be considered by the selection panel.
