The annual *StArt Up: Top Arts 2016* exhibition presents outstanding work completed by student artists as part of their assessment for VCE Art and Studio Arts. VCE Art requires students to complete a body of work including at least two finished artworks, that demonstrates creativity and imagination, the evolution of ideas and the realisation of appropriate concepts, knowledge and skills. VCE Studio Arts requires students to complete an exploration proposal

and a design process that includes investigation of potential directions and the production of a cohesive folio of finished artworks. This exhibition highlights the NGV's strong commitment to contemporary art and arts education, and showcases the ideas and attitudes of young people through works in a diversity of media including painting, drawing, sculpture, multimedia and installation.

VCE Art and Studio Arts - Writing about art workshop intensive

This workshop will focus on improving students' ability to write clearly about works of art using appropriate art language and terminology. Working both individually and collaboratively in small groups, students will complete exercises designed to build their skills and confidence in writing. This will encompass visual analysis and annotation as well as longer responses including the use of Analytical Frameworks online for VCE Art students, writing an opinion based on images and commentary and writing insightful comparisons. Maximum 12 students. Cost \$14 (2 hrs/NGV I)
