Top Arts 2017 is an exhibition of selected work from students who completed VCE Art or Studio Arts in 2016. *Top Arts* is displayed in the NGV Design Studio at The Ian Potter Centre: NGV Australia in Federation Square. It is the NGV's only annual exhibition.

THE EXHIBITION SPACE

How is the work arranged in the exhibition space? Are the works grouped in any particular way e.g. thematic groupings (by idea or medium) or aesthetic groupings (by colour or visual similarity)? How does the exhibition design affect the way audiences might perceive the artworks in the exhibition?

ANALYTICAL FRAMEWORKS

STRUCTURAL FRAMEWORK

Choose a work (or works) of art that appeal(s) to you.

What is the name and title of the work? What medium has been used?

Briefly describe the work.

THE EXHIBITION

What is the main feeling or quality of the work? How have art elements and principles been applied to create this quality? What is the main idea or concept behind the work? How do the materials and techniques contribute to the underlying concept or idea?

Find another work of art that appeals to you.

Write the name of the work and name of the artist.

Use the **contemporary**, **cultural** or **personal** framework to discuss the work.

(Remember:

Personal Framework: how an artist's experiences, feelings, thinking and personal philosophy are reflected in the work of art.

Contemporary framework: how current ideas and viewpoints affect our understanding of a work of art.

Cultural framework: how the influence of physical, historical, social, cultural and political settings is evident in an artwork.)

THE FOLIOS
