PRAMS

NGV International and The Ian Potter Centre: NGV Australia are fully pram accessible and you are welcome to take your pram into Gallery spaces. Any large bags that are not stored underneath prams will need to be cloaked. The Great Hall and Grollo Equiset Garden are great places for children to roam, relax, stretch their leas or lie back and gaze at the stained-glass ceiling.
