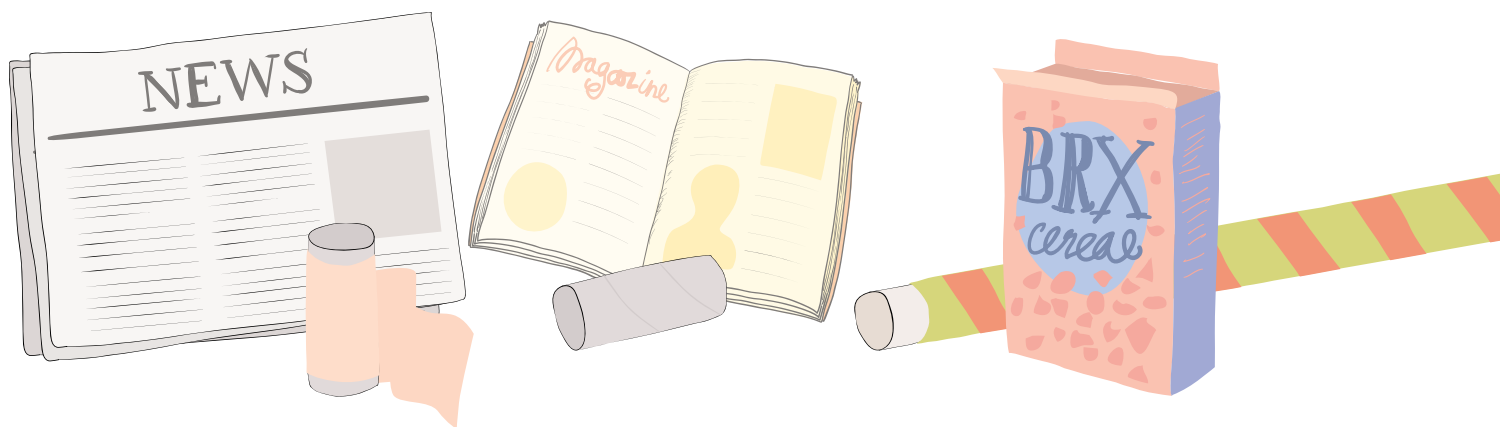
Alexandra cares about the environment and uses her art to remind people that it's important to take care of our world. She uses leftover material from her family's factory to make her carpets. This is called **repurposing**.

Repurposing is using materials or objects that may have been thrown away to make something new.
