Entry Restrictions	Open only to Australian residents, except directors, officers, management and employees (and the immediate families of directors, officers, management and employees associated with this competition) of the Promoter, or of the agencies or companies associated with this competition. Entrants must be over the age of 18
Competition Period	9am (AEDT) on 5 June 2025 to 5pm (AEST) on 7 October 2025.

Draw Details	The draw will be conducted as an electronic draw, taking place at 10am AEST Tuesday 7 October 2025 at 180 St Kilda Road, Melbourne VIC 3006.
Winner Determination	The first valid entry randomly drawn from all valid entries received during the Competition Period will win the prize.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1 Information regarding prizes and how to enter forms part of these conditions. By entering, entrants agree to accept these conditions.
- 2 The competition will be conducted during the Competition Period.
- 3 All valid entries must be received during the Competition Period. Entries are deemed to be received at the time they are submitted by the entrant. Entries that do not contain a valid email address and contact number of the entrant may be disqualified.
- 4 The Promoter is not liable for late, lost, incomplete, misdirected, incorrectly submitted, delayed or illegible entries, correspondence or claims for prizes due to error, omission, tampering, theft, destruction or otherwise.
- 5 The draw will be conducted at the time, on the date and at the location as stated in the Draw Details.
- 6 The prize is as stated in the Prize Details.
- 7 The winner will be notified in accordance with the Winner Notification and Publication section of these conditions.
- 8 The Promoter may require the winner to provide proof of identity, proof of age and proof of residency. Identification considered suitable for verification of these details is at the Promoter's discretion.
- 9 If a winning entry is deemed not to comply with these conditions of entry, the entry will be discarded and a new winner of that prize will be selected in accordance with paragraph 5, or in accordance with the Unclaimed Prize Draw Details, as applicable.

- 16 If for any reason any aspect of this competition is not capable of running as planned, including by reason of computer virus, communications network failure, bugs, tampering, unauthorised intervention, fraud, technical failure or any cause beyond the control of the Promoter, the Promoter may in its sole discretion cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the competition, or invalidate any affected entries, subject to the approval of the relevant gaming authority if required.
- 17 The Promoter and the Prize Suppliers are not liable for any tax implications arising from prize winnings. Independent financial advice should be sought. Where this competition involves, for GST purposes, supplies being made for non-monetary consideration, entrants will follow the Australian Taxation Office's stated view that where the parties are at arm's length, goods and services exchanged are of equal GST inclusive market values.
