

NGVWA GARDEN DAY

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF PUBLIC ENTRY

Welcome to NGVWA Garden Day 2026. The NGVWA is a group of volunteers who fundraise through events to support the NGV Collection.

By entering these private gardens, each person agrees to be bound by the following Terms and Conditions of Entry:

- Tickets must be presented at each garden for entry.
- NGV reserves the right to inspect any bag, luggage or object, however described, upon entry to these gardens.
- Animals are not permitted except for Guide Dogs and other registered or accredited assistance dogs.
- Picnics, smoking (including e-cigarettes and vapes) and the consumption of alcohol, are prohibited.
- Recreational battery powered means of transport are not permitted, unless they are accredited mobility aids.
- Spruiking, distributing unauthorised printed material or merchandise, signature gathering, soliciting business, or conducting other not for profit activities, is not permitted.
- On-site private restroom facilities are not accessible to ticketholders. Please use public facilities shown on the map.
- Surveillance systems may be operational in the gardens and visitors may be recorded. These are not operated by the NGV.
- Photography and videos of the houses are not permitted except by assigned professionals commissioned by the NGVWA. Official photographers and videographers will capture footage and images on the day for use in NGVWA social media and subsequent Garden Day promotions. Please advise the photographers/videographers or the volunteer garden attendants if you do not wish to be photographed.
- Take reasonable care when moving through the gardens, including using handrails where available.
- Certain areas of the gardens are not accessible to ticketholders. Visitors must comply with all directions given by volunteer garden attendants, NGV staff and security personnel at all times.
- While you are participating in NGVWA Garden Day, visitors must conduct themselves in a manner which, in the reasonable opinion of the NGV, does not interfere with, disrupt or offend other persons, or cause damage to property.
- Physical or verbal abuse or aggression towards other visitors, NGV staff, contractors or volunteers will not be tolerated and may result in removal from the event without refund.
- The NGVWA, NGV staff and those responsible for the property reserve the right to refuse entry to, or remove from the event, any person who fails to comply with these Conditions of Entry.
